## **Community support creates a** new Pulmonary Functions Lab

Thanks to your support, our YRMC
Foundation was able to provide funding to establish a second state-of-the-art pulmonary functions lab. Creation of the second lab was in response to a rapid increase in demand. According to Scott Cerreta, YRMC's Director of Respiratory Care, patient volumes have increased significantly as we receive more and more referrals from across northern Arizona. As Scott explained, "In 2023, our Respiratory Therapy team conducted approximately 2,000 PFTs (Pulmonary Function Tests). With the addition of

Tests). With the addition of the new lab, we will be able to accommodate twice that number and can expect to perform 4,000 tests annually."

PFTs include different types of breathing tests that measure how well our lungs exchange air. Some also measure how well lungs absorb oxygen and how exercise affects them. The tests are safe and are noninvasive. Results from a PFT often guides a physician's evaluation of a patient's overall health and helps identify medications that may be used to treat symptoms.

## Healthy nutrition choices for breast cancer patients

Last spring, more than 50 breast cancer patients, breast cancer survivors, their caregivers, and YRMC staff attended a most informative cooking demonstration to learn about healthy nutritional choices specifically tailored for cancer patients. In collaboration with the Baskin Breast Care Center's Heart & Soul support group, the program was coordinated by Kate Hanni, YRMC Foundation Manager of Philanthropy, whose personal health journey inspired her quest to research optimal nutritional choices and ultimately redesign her diet.

Program attendees enjoyed a five-course dinner prepared by Kate's husband, Tim Hanni, a professional chef and nationally recognized Master of Wine. Each course

Designed for newly graduated nurses, the program combines classroom instruction specific to nursing specialties with clinical

experience under the supervision and guidance of preceptors, coaches, and the program director. Our investment in this program will help to ensure our patients continue to receive exceptional care.

Additionally, we hope our commitment to continually invest in the advancement of our staff will serve to both attract and retain top-flight clinicians. Thus far in the program, 111 Nurse Preceptors, who mentor and guide new nurse residents to ensure a smooth transition from

academic settings to clinical practice, have been trained. And we have welcomed 46 new Nurse Residents to the program.

Through rigorous training and handson experience, these new nurses are prepared to meet the challenges of today's healthcare environment and to continue our commitment to provide quality and compassionate care close to home.

#### October is National Estate Planning Awareness Month

October is National Estate Planning Awareness Month. And because nearly 64% of adults do not have a Last Will and Testament or Trust, we wish to remind everyone of the importance of creating and/or maintaining an estate plan.

In short, an estate plan is necessary to manage one's lifetime accumulation of wealth. It can help provide for the care and security for family members and will spare them from having to make difficult decisions without the benefit of your voice. It will also avoid the cost of the expensive probate process.

A Last Will and Testament, a Durable Power of Attorney, and a Living Will are the three estate planning documents one needs to have in place. A Trust may also be included, as this document addresses the distribution of assets and eliminates the need for probate. A cautionary note: When a person dies without a Last Will and Testament or a Trust, the individual's assets are distributed according to laws of that state.

There are many reasons to have an estate plan. Hopefully this reminder will move the creation of a Last Will or Trust up a notch or two in your list of priorities. Or perhaps if you already have these documents in place, it will encourage you to review your plans to make certain they are up-to-date.

#### An important note regarding IRA distributions

Qualified charitable distributions can be made only to qualified charities. Qualified charities do not include those which are classified as 509(a)(3) Supporting Organizations, including the YRMC Foundation.

In order to be qualified for favorable tax treatment, your IRA qualified charitable distribution must be made directly from your IRA custodian to our supported organization, Yavapai Regional Medical Center, Tax ID 86-0098923. As with non-IRA donations, your gift will be designated to your specified fund of choice.


