## Panda Infant Warmers Keep Vulnerable Babies at Healthy Temperatures

Earlier this year, funds were used to purchase two GE Panda Infant Warmers thanks to donations to the YRMC Foundation's Community Care Fund.

These units have replaced 20+ year outdated warmers and will help our Emergency Department (ED) staff at the West and East Campuses maintain a baby's body temperature at normal levels which is imperative for their health. Without this intervention, they may experience hypothermia which can impair their bodily and organic functions.

Our ED nursing staff guided us through some of the many improvements in the new units, including seamless setting of accurate oxygen-to-air ratios based on infant age and ease in adjusting temperature levels.
